We are offering another opportunity for families to earn money to cover cost of the higher activity fee. Parents are asked to volunteer in the concession stand throughout the season. In hopes to encourage more parents to be involved, we've added a \$5 an hour wage for parents who wish to earn some money to cover the cost of the activity fee. We understand that the activity fee increase will be difficult for families to budget around, and our hope is that this opportunity in the concession stand will help ease the transition to a higher activity fee. More details of this program will be shared in August, prior to the season starting.

The total cost of a student-athlete participating in a sport costs the athletic boosters approximately \$350-\$400. The budget for the entire athletic program is approximately \$40,000 each year. We believe it's important to keep that cost down for all our families. Our biggest fundraisers for the athletic program are: Magazine Sale, Concession Stand, Admissions, and the Hot lunch program.
